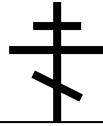

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

We are now approaching the holy season of Holy Week and Pascha when we should make extra efforts too attend the services and concentrate on spiritual things. As our Holy Week occurs at the same time as the western one, I am available to serve more of the services than usual. Please try to attend some of the extra services if you can. If enough of you can attend on Holy and Great Thursday morning for instance, we could do the washing of the feet. There is a full Pannikhida on Lazarus Saturday, 16th April when all your departed loved ones can be remembered. Please prepare lists of your families and friends and prepare Koliva.

Please help to prepare the church for the services. There will be a polishing session after the Pannikhida on Saturday 16th April so that everything is bright and shining ready for the Feast.

Please also invite your friends to the services of Great Friday and Pascha itself. Last year we had well over 70. Perhaps we will have many more this year. If you know of isolated Orthodox Christians who might need a lift, please help to get them to church and perhaps ask them to stay the night at your home. For the first time, I am putting on a service on the Sunday morning of Pascha as last year various people came to church in the hope of lighting a candle. You may receive Holy Communion at both Liturgies of Pascha, the Holy Saturday one and the midnight one. I hope to see as many of you as possible during this holy season.

On Saturday May 21st we have a new venture when the Holy Liturgy will be served in Liverpool at the Anglican Parish Church at the Pier Head (St Nick's). The hours will begin at about 10:00 a.m. in the Lady Chapel. If you can sing in Slavonic, please see Alina who has kindly volunteered to sing for the occasion. In future, we will serve on one Saturday each term. If you know of Orthodox Students at the Universities of Liverpool, please encourage them to attend.
